Dear Parents/Carers

On the subject of attendance I am disappointed to see a rapid decline in our overall attendance percentage these last few weeks. Every moment in school counts and days missed add up very quickly. The higher a pupil's attendance, the more likely they are to progress and achieve their learning goals. If your child has a medical or dental appointment during school time, you will need to provide the school office with a copy of the appointment. Without this, the absence will be classes as unauthorised. I would like to see an overall improvement in the attendance for the last few weeks of term.

General Notices and Reminders

Health and Safety

For the health and safety of all our children please ensure that your child does not ride their bicycle or scooter in the school playground. Ideally these should be left outside the school gate. If they are to be brought into the playground they must not be ridden around.

Toast in school

Although we are currently providing toast each morning for our children, this is meant to supplement breakfast already taken at home. A few children have told staff that they have not had breakfast due to getting breakfast in school. The toast offered each morning during registration, is to supplement and not substitute breakfast. Please can you ensure your child comes to school each day already having had their breakfast.

Debt

As we approach the end of the academic year it is important to ensure that any outstanding money owed on children's accounts for meals or breakfast club is cleared. Debts outstanding at the end of the term will be passed on to NYC debt collection department. After this week there are two full weeks and two days left for school meals. If you wish to get ahead and apply credit to your child's account please pay £36.00 on to Parentpay.

Free School Meals

If you think you might be eligible for free school meals please contact the office for an application form. If your child is in Year 2 and moving into Year 3 this September, their entitlement to Universal Free School meals will end. Unless you have already been awarded free school meals you will need to pay for meals in Year 3.

Sun-Cream

A reminder to apply sun cream to your child before school ideally one that lasts for the day. Children are asking to apply sun cream in class stating that sun cream has not already been applied at home.
