## Our Learning This Week.....Class 2

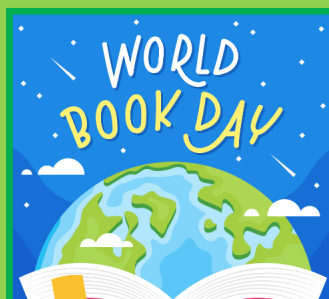
