Our Learning This Week.....Class 1

We have had a lovely week in Class 1 and enjoyed welcoming our extra `visitors' from Class 2 at the beginning of the week.

We have tasted and evaluated fruit and vegetables using our senses. When sorting the fruit and vegetables, the children were surprised at some of the things that ended up on the fruit pile. We found out that: fruit comes from plants, the fruit is produced from the flower, a fruit encloses a seed or seeds that would allow another plant to grow.

Once our fruit kebabs were made it was fantastic for the children to be able to share them with you in school. It gave the children real design focus for their product.
