Our Learning This Week.....Class 1

In Class 1 this week we have been investigating Diwali in music. We have found that this is a Hindu festival of light which is not always on the same day as it happens when there is a new moon and is the darkest day of the lunar month.

We investigated how the moon looks like it Changes over the month when we can see more or less of it, depending how much is in shadow. For many people, Diwali is a five day festival where they Clean the home, exchange gifts, decorate buildings and enjoy firework displays.

In maths this week, the Children have been Continuing to add and subtract using a range of different resources. The Children in Reception have been learning that every number can be made up of one.









Our Learning This Week.....Class 2

In Computing this week, we have begun tinkering on SCratch. We have changed our sprites, made them move and have even added our own sound effects.

We also had a visit from Malton Science Bus, this provided a great opportunity for the Children to share their knowledge of the human body as well as food and nutrition. They also carried out some experiments, testing different foods.

In English, we have begun reading 'The Boy, The Mole, The Fox and The Horse' by Charlie Mackesey. The children have really impressed us with their use of speech punctuation and amazing vocabulary choices.


