This week in Class 2, we have been working extremely hard. We have had an exciting week exploring all kinds of different things.

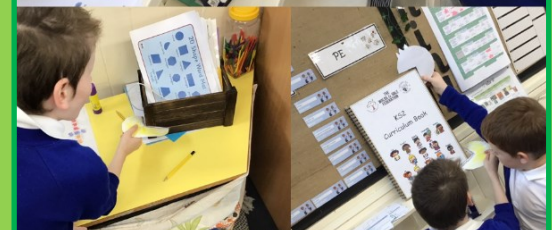
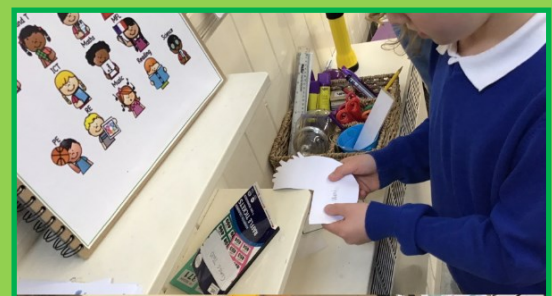

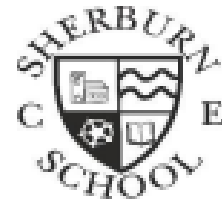
