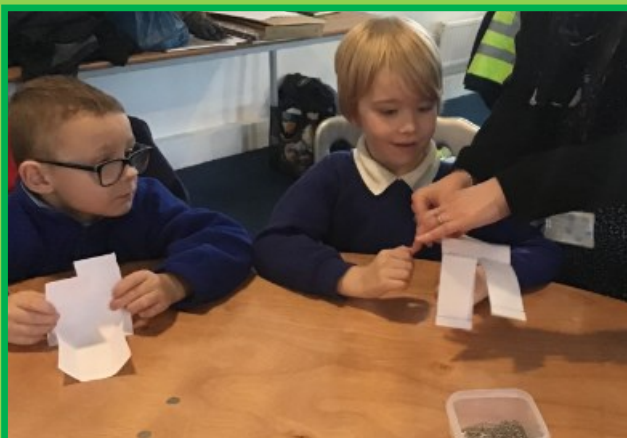
Our Learning This Week.....Class 1

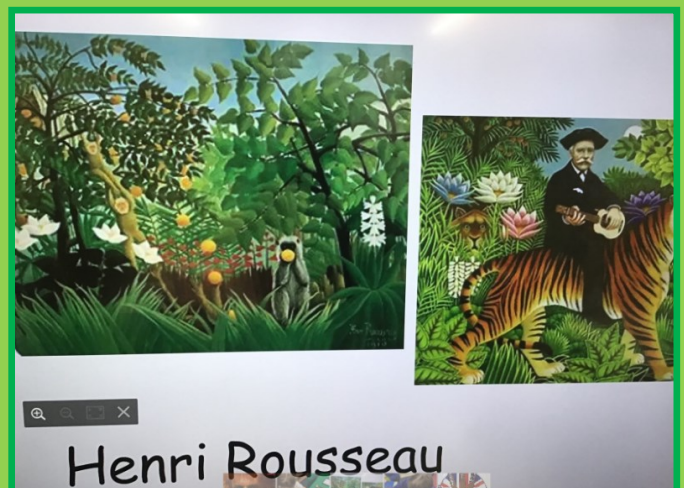
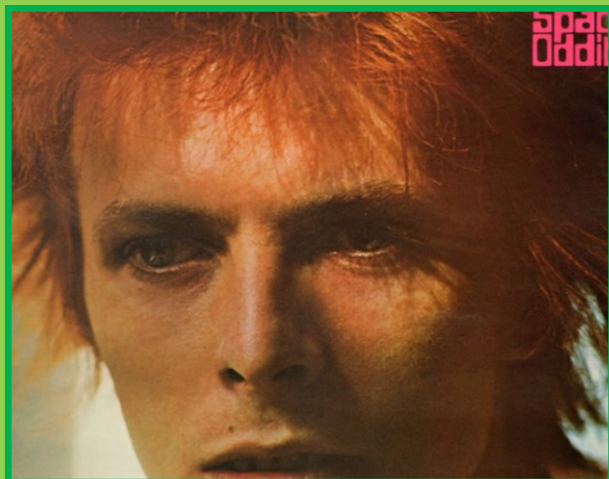
Our Learning This Week.....Class 2

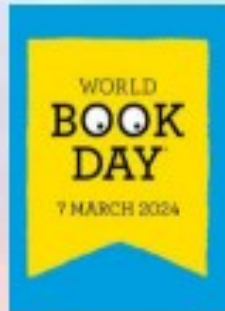
