Dear Parents/Carers

Another lovely week across both schools! It has been a real pleasure this week to talk to Children about their learning and to hear them talk with such confidence and enthusiasm!

In our assemblies each week, we are beginning to learn more about Federation

In PE this week we have been playing 'Snake Tag' which was an exciting way to begin to learn about skills in tag rugby.







Our Learning This Week.....Class 2


