#### Our Learning This Week.....Class 1


This week in Class 1, we have been investigating shapes. The Early Years children have been looking at numbers of blocks that will make a rectangle.

Lots of the Children in Class 1 have been excited to share their learning of tricky words and eager to Change the words on their key rings.




### Our Learning This Week.....Class 2
