Our Learning This Week.....Class 1

In class 1 this week, we have been investigating how we know about events that have happened in the past as, depending how long ago an event happened, there is nobody who is still alvie to tell us about it. We have found that there are primary and secondary sources of information.

We have been reading a story called 'Mapping Sam' and have been thinking about verbs (how an animal moves) and adverbs (the manner in which it moves) to write sentences about our animals.







Our Learning This Week.....Class 2

In Science, we have been investigating what plants need to grow. We are currently investigating how water affects the growth of a plant.



In PE we have been working on our stamina, by increasing the distance we can run and also practising relay races.
