


In art this term, we have been making Egyptian death masks.

In other News.....

Holidays in Term Time

There have been some holiday requests from parents and Carers at both schools to take holidays during term time. Whilst I fully appreciate the need to do this - the increased cost of holidays outside of term time, the restrictions on taking leave from work in term time - holidays during term time Cannot be authorised absences as per the Department for Education Guidance. If you are planning a holiday, please speak to a member of the Admin Team and ask for a Holiday Request Form. This needs to be completed so that we are aware of the dates the Children will be absent and the fact they are on holiday - this is for safeguarding purposes.

Bank Holiday and Training Day

A reminder that Monday April 17th is a Training Day and schools will be closed. The Children return after the Easter break on Tuesday April 18th 2023.

There is another Training Day on Friday June 25th when schools will be closed. This will be the final Training Day of the school year.
